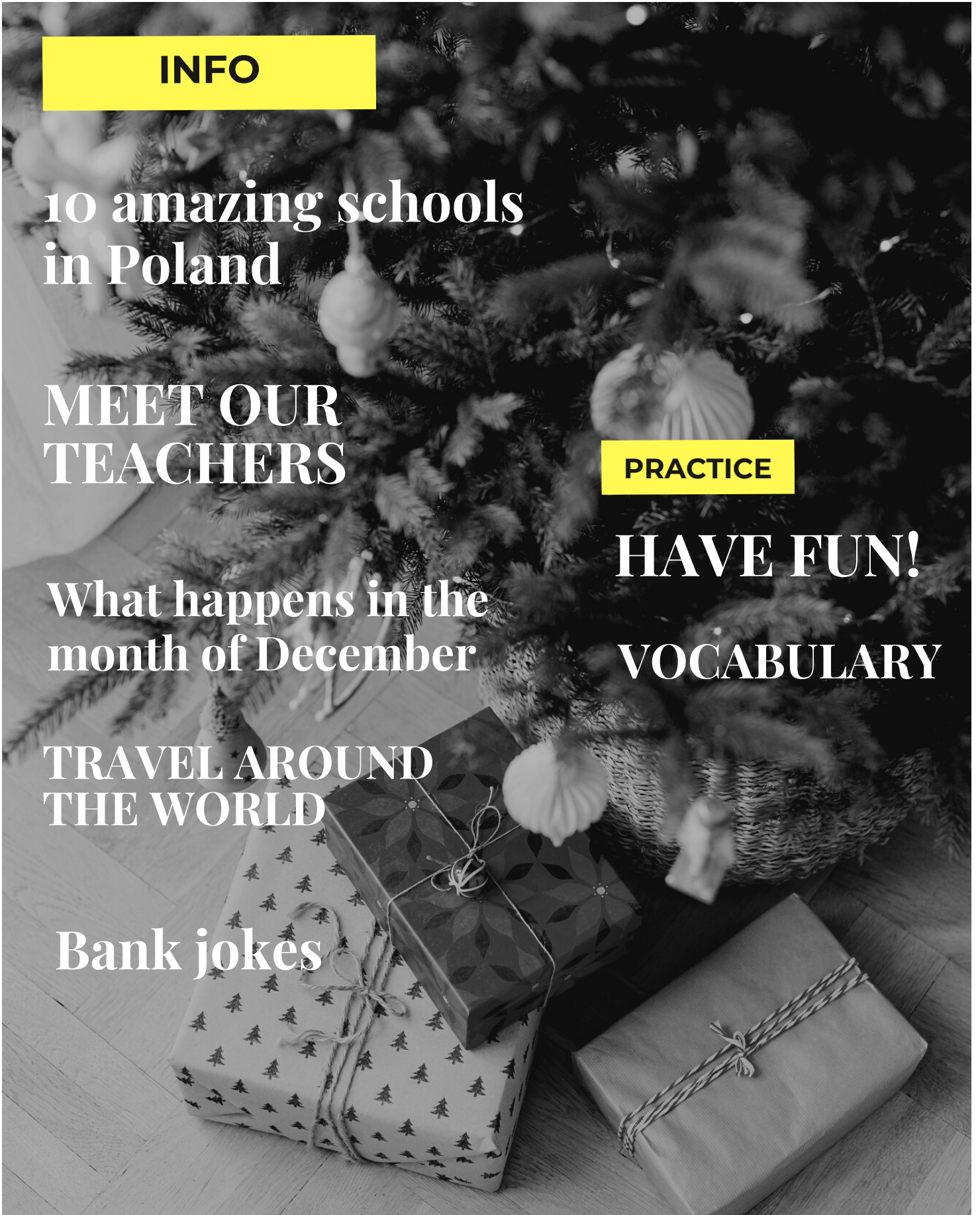

WHAT HAPPENS IN THE MONTH OF DECEMBER

Christmas

Christmas is a celebration that lasts for several days. In the UK and many other countries, the main celebration takes place on Christmas Day (25 December). From the Christian origins of the holiday, this day marks the birth of Jesus Christ. Christmas Eve (24 December) is the time for last-minute shopping and preparations, present-wrapping and maybe a drink in the pub. Others will be at home preparing food for the big day or at a midnight church service to welcome Christmas Day. Boxing Day (26 December) is also a national holiday in the UK – a necessary one for many, to recover after eating too much the day before! Shops are usually open on Boxing Day and the big after-Christmas sales begin.

Special days

Decorations

From huge cities to tiny villages, the month of December sees buildings and streets covered in coloured lights, red ribbons and smiling Santa Claus faces. People also decorate their houses (and sometimes their gardens) for the Christmas period. The most famous decoration is, of course, the Christmas tree – a pine tree covered in little shiny decorations and fairy lights. Some people put a nativity scene in their house. This is a collection of little figures who represent the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem.

Family and friends

Christmas is a time to be with the people you love. Often, this involves travelling to your hometown to be with parents, siblings, cousins, old friends, etc. For some households, it's the only time of the year when all the family is together. In the UK, this is usually a time for chats, cups of tea and watching Christmas films together. However, it can also lead to occasional family tension. But don't worry: there are plenty of impossibly cheerful pop songs to help everyone relax!

Food

Christmas meals vary across households, but the most common Christmas dinner in the UK is a roasted turkey with vegetables and potatoes. This may be accompanied by stuffing (made with bread, onions and herbs) and pigs in blankets (sausages wrapped in bacon or pastry). And, of course, delicious mince pies – little sweet cakes with fruit inside. This is, of course, fantastic if someone is cooking for you. If you're the cook, you may feel under a little pressure as the extended family start arriving for dinner!

Presents

Christmas is certainly the most wonderful time of the year for retailers! The days and weeks before Christmas are characterised by frantic shopping for presents. Many groups of friends or workmates take part in a 'Secret Santa' group. This is where each person buys a small present for one other person in the group, but the identity of the giver is never revealed. In many countries, Christmas Eve is a night for kids to go to bed early before their house is visited by Santa Claus, a magic man in a red suit who leaves presents for all the kids in the house.

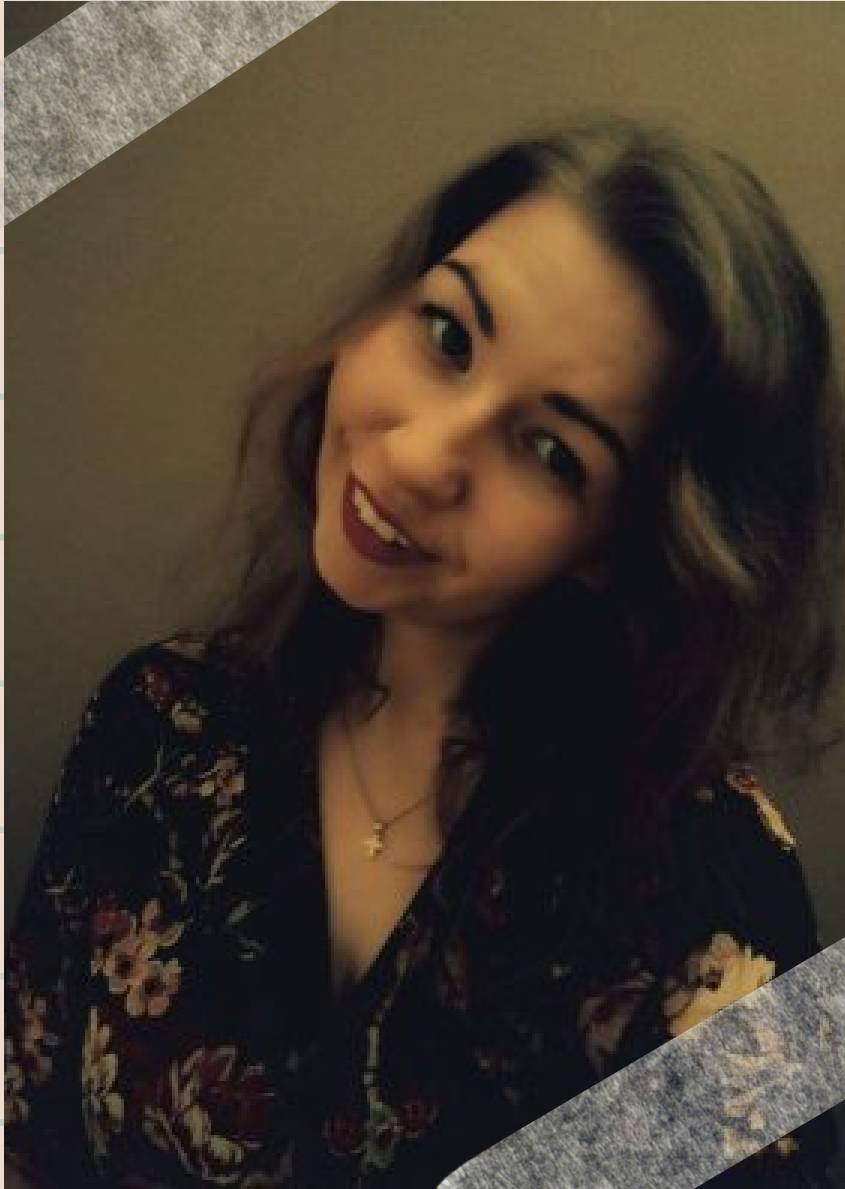
-I have seen many beautiful places, but the most beautiful of them are our mountains.

Zespół Szkół Mistrzostwa Sportowego „Stal” w Rzeszowie

We are Zespół Szkół Mistrzostwa Sportowego „Stal” in Rzeszów, in the Podkarpackie Voivodeship. We have been operating since 2019 as a primary school and a high school. The originator and founder is the President of the Football Club "Stal Rzeszów" Mr. Rafał Kalisz. The principal of our school is Mrs. Ewelina Greszczuk-Sokół and we have got two vice principals Mrs. Monika Kozdraś-Grzesik and Mr. Michał Ratajczak. They supervise the implementation of the school's mission and vision.

The aim of our activity is an advance of knowledge among students, as well as sports, in particular football. The effect of learning is to prepare players ready to play in the first team. Our training plan is based on four pillars - technique, tactics, motor skills and mentality.

Our school invites students from the fourth grade of primary school. We must learn English and the second language to choose is German or Italian. We have an educational activities as in any educational institution but we also offer a lot of training hours in the football, table tennis and ballroom dancing sections. We were champions of the Central Junior League several times in football. We took high places

in the world and European championships in table tennis and ballroom dancing, too. Lessons are conducted by teachers with many years of experience, who are involved in the teaching process. Sports activities are conducted by trainers, instructors and coordinators with extensive professional experience in the country and abroad.

We learn in classrooms equipped with interactive boards and multimedia projectors. The building has two large assembly halls, a dining room and a common room with a relaxation area.

We take part in Erasmus+ and POWER. As part of the mobility of students and school staff, we participated in trips to Germany, Turkey and Italy and Portugal, where we had the opportunity to develop our school and sports skills by participating in football tournaments with local teams.

We are located in the very center of Rzeszów, and the School provides club bus transport that transports students living far from the school building and to trainings. We train on the pitches of the "Stal" Rzeszów City Stadium.

Who lives far away can live in a well-equipped dormitory "Rooms" 😊. We provide rooms with kitchenettes, private bathrooms, study space, gym and fitness as well as a relaxation and games zone.

10 niezwykłych szkół w Polsce:

Zespół Szkół Mistrzostwa Sportowego „Stal” w Rzeszowie

Jesteśmy Zespołem Szkół Mistrzostwa Sportowego „Stal” w Rzeszowie, w województwie podkarpackim. Działamy od 2019 roku, jako Szkoła Podstawowa oraz Liceum Ogólnokształcące. Pomysłodawcą i założycielem jest Prezes Klubu Piłkarskiego „Stali Rzeszów” Pan Rafał Kalisz. Dyrektorem Szkoły jest Pani Ewelina Greszczuk-Sokół, która wraz z vice Dyrektorem Panią Moniką Kozdraś-Grzesik oraz Panem Michałem Ratajczakiem czuwają nad realizacją misji i wizji Szkoły.

Celem naszej działalności jest rozwijanie wiedzy powszechnej wśród uczniów, a także sportowej, w szczególności piłkarskiej. Efektem nauki ma być przygotowanie zawodników gotowych do gry w pierwszym zespole. Nasz plan szkolenia opiera się na czterech filarach – technice, taktyce, motoryce i mentalności.

Nasza Szkoła zaprasza uczniów już od klasy IV szkoły podstawowej. Obowiązkowo uczymy się języka angielskiego, a drugi język do wyboru to niemiecki lub włoski. Realizujemy zajęcia edukacyjne tak jak w każdej placówce oświatowej, a ponadto oferujemy sporo godzin treningów w sekcji piłki nożnej, tenisa stołowego oraz tańca towarzyskiego. W piłce nożnej kilkakrotnie byliśmy mistrzami Centralnej Ligi Juniorów, a w tenisie stołowym i tańcu towarzyskim zajmowaliśmy wysokie miejsca w mistrzostwach świata i Europy.

Lekcje prowadzą nauczyciele z wieloletnim stażem, angażując się w proces nauczania. Zajęcia sportowe prowadzą natomiast trenerzy, instruktorzy i koordynatorzy mający spore doświadczenie zawodowe w kraju i za granicą.

Uczymy się w salach wyposażonych w tablice interaktywne, projektory multimedialne. Na terenie budynku znajdują się dwie duże aule, jadalnia oraz świetlica ze strefą relaksu.

Realizujemy liczne projekty międzynarodowe Erasmus+ i POWER. W ramach mobilności uczniów i kadry szkolnej uczestniczyliśmy w podróżach do Niemiec, Turcji, Włoch i Portugalii, gdzie mieliśmy możliwość rozwijania swoich umiejętności szkolnych oraz sportowych, uczestnicząc w piłkarskich turniejach z lokalnymi drużynami.

Znajdujemy się w ścisłym centrum Rzeszowa, a Szkoła zapewnia klubową komunikację autobusową, która dowozi i odwozi uczniów mieszkających daleko od budynku szkoły oraz na treningi. Trenujemy na boiskach Stadionu Miejskiego Stali Rzeszów.

Kto mieszka daleko, może zamieszkać w świetnie wyposażonej bursie „Roomy” 😊. Zapewniamy pokoje z aneksami kuchennymi, prywatną łazienką, przestrzenią do nauki, siłownią i fitness oraz strefą relaksu i gier.



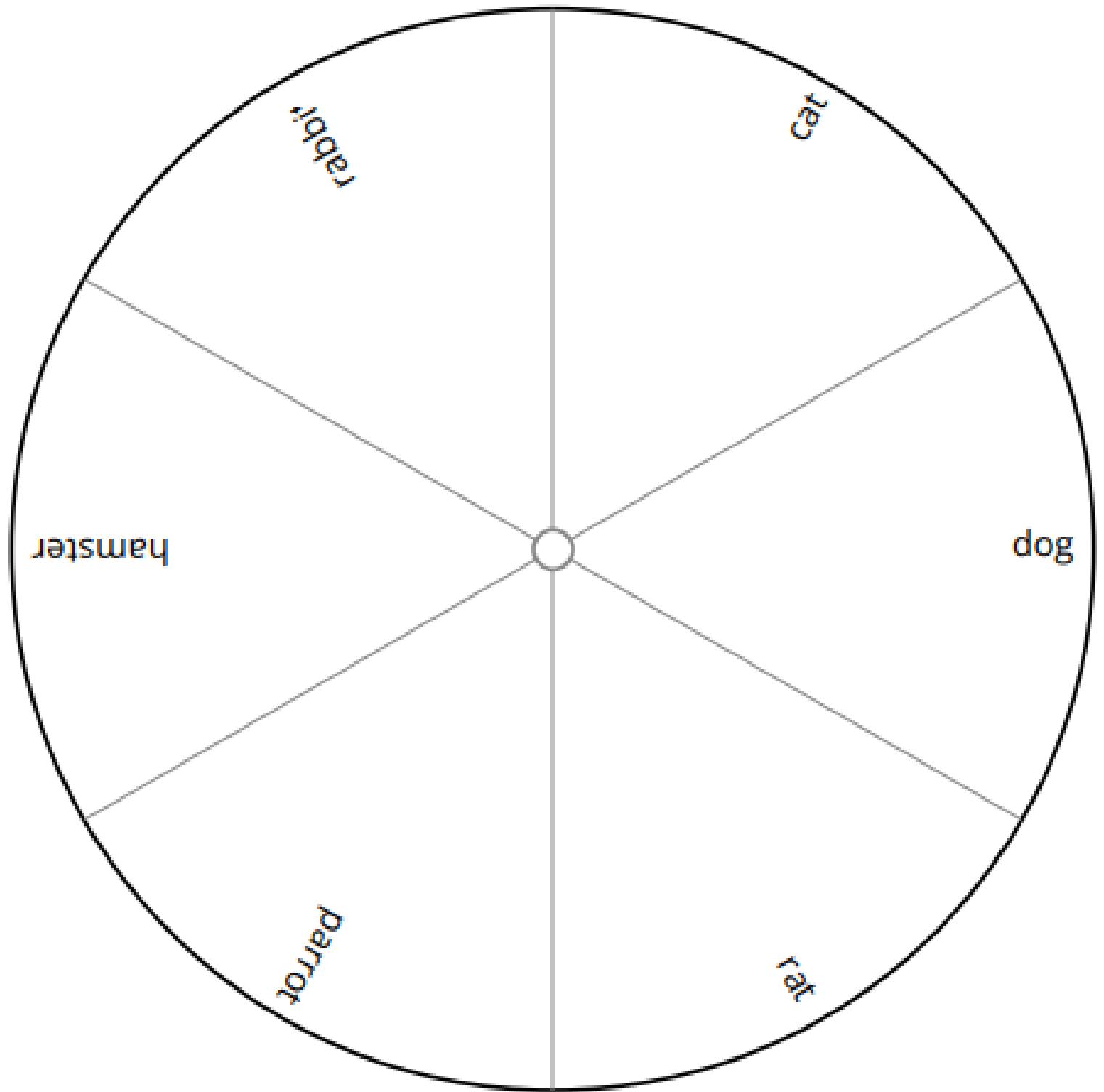

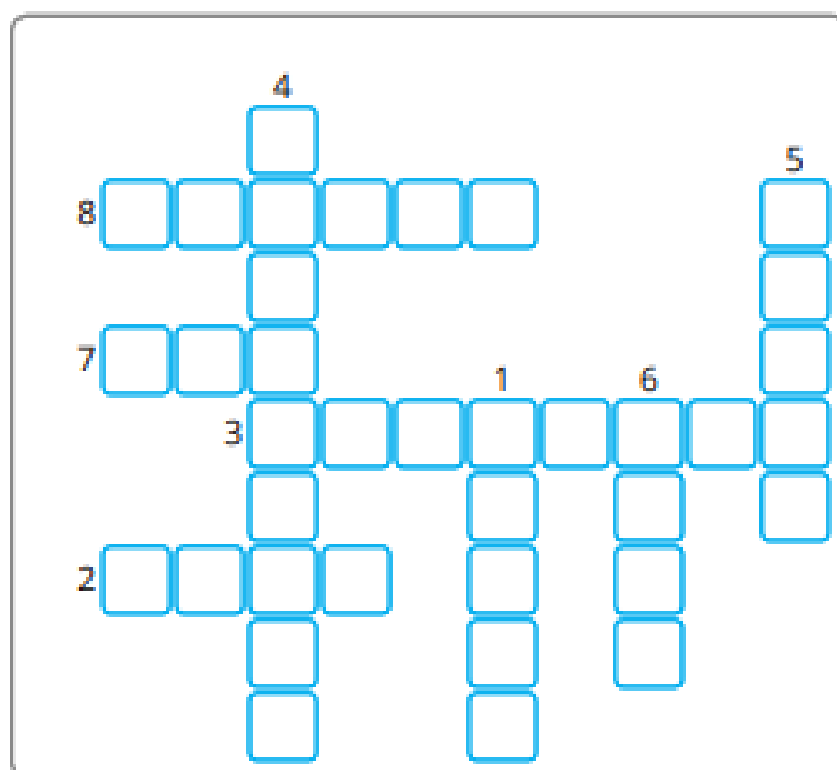
